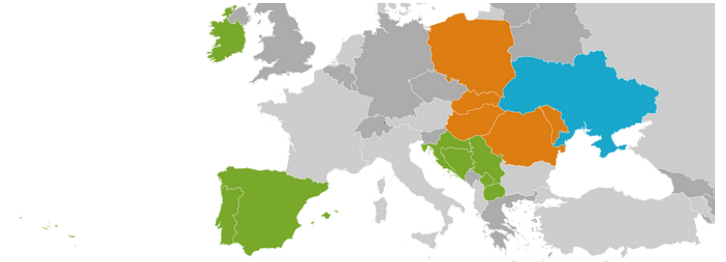

Millions have been forced to flee their homes, and millions more remain displaced or in need in Ukraine. Upon the outbreak of this conflict, the Society of Jesus coordinated a global response through JRS and Xavier Network in Ukraine, neighboring countries, and the rest of Europe to welcome, protect, promote, and integrate those in need.

People served in 6 months of 2023 **23.725**

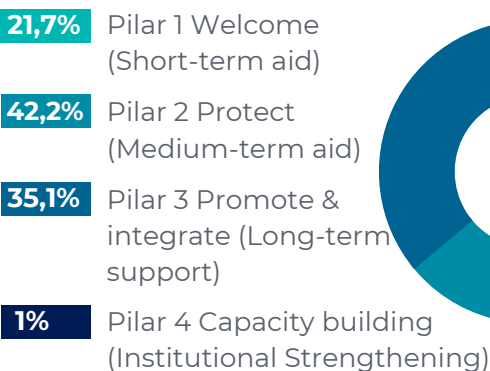
People served since the start of the conflict **79.767**

 ■ Countries of secondary movement

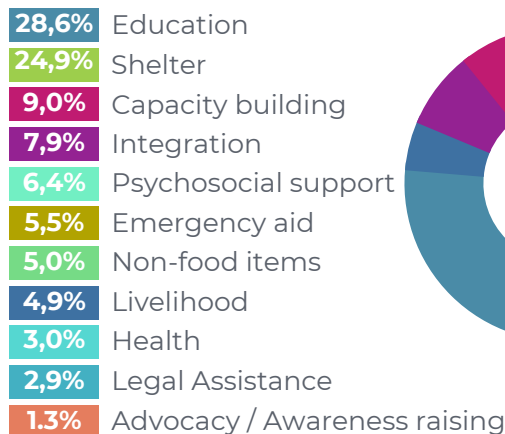


Activities overview
