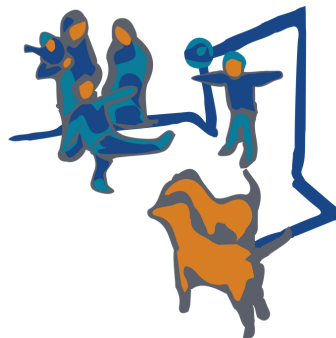
Jesuit Support to the Ukraine Crisis

INTERIM REPORT

The International Armed Conflict in Ukraine has caused the largest humanitarian crisis in Europe in recent history. Millions have been forced to flee their homes, and millions more remain displaced or in need in Ukraine. Upon the outbreak of this conflict, the **Society of Jesus** coordinated a global response through JRS and Xavier Network in Ukraine, neighboring countries, and the rest of Europe to welcome, protect, promote, and integrate those in need.

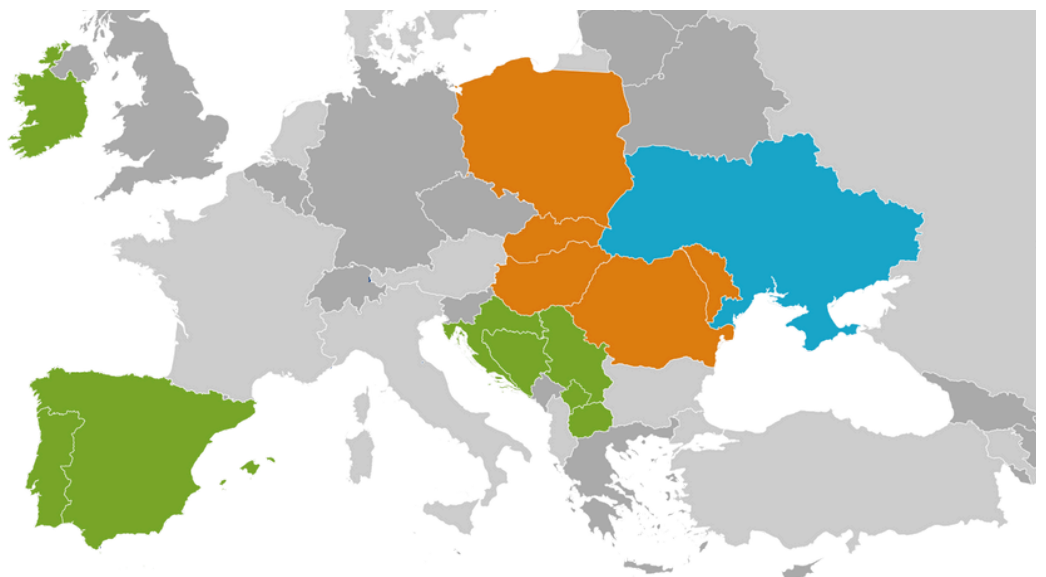

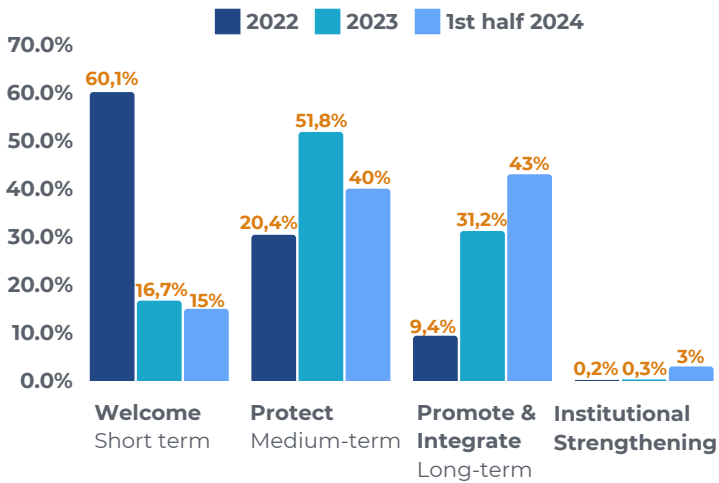

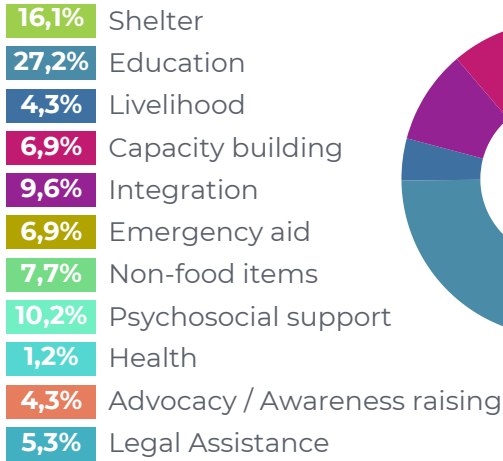


Activities overview

Gulina's Story

The war shook Gulina. “My life revolved around my family and taking care of my children”, says Gulina. “Finding housing was our biggest challenge because we had nowhere to go and no concrete plans. We felt hopeless and lost. My sons and I are very grateful to JRS Ukraine for the accommodation and all the help they have given us. We feel safe here, and there is a good place for children's leisure and development”, Gulina highlights.

Svitlana's Story

Still, she highlights the biggest impact has been social activities that helped her find a community, which is “exactly what we needed”.
