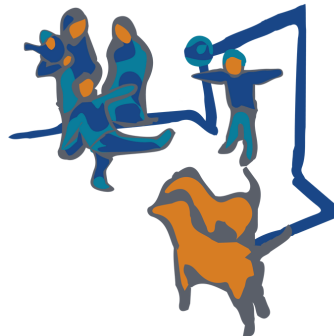

ANNUAL REPORT

The International Armed Conflict in Ukraine has caused the largest humanitarian crisis in Europe in recent history. Millions have been forced to flee their homes, and millions more remain displaced or in need in Ukraine. Upon the outbreak of this conflict, the **Society of Jesus** coordinated a global response through JRS and Xavier Network in Ukraine, neighboring countries, and the rest of Europe to welcome, protect, promote, and integrate those in need.

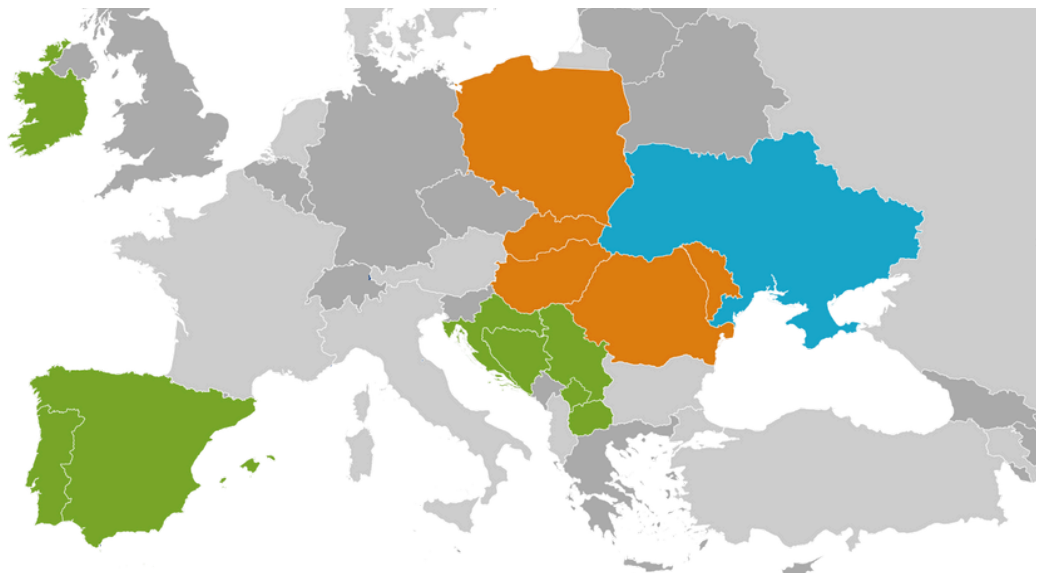

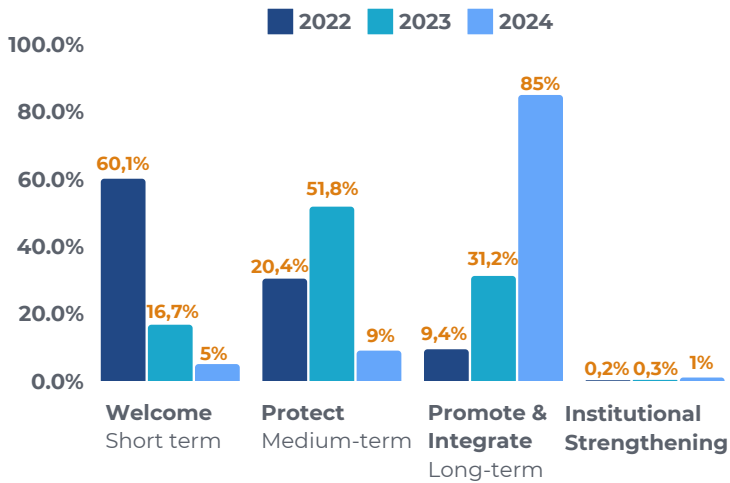

Lyudmila's Story

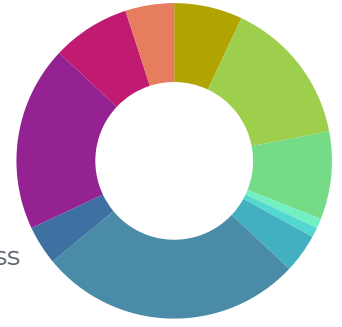
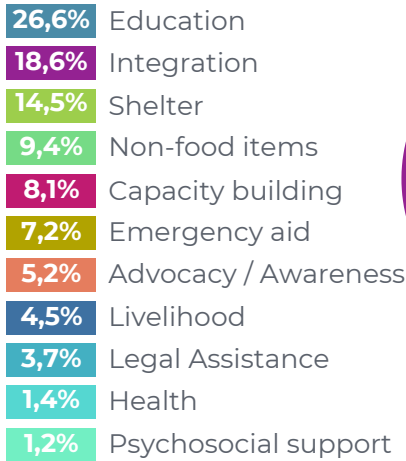
"Everything familiar and dear to us was left behind: memories of my children's happy childhood and belongings that tied us to my late husband. We just travelled into the unknown", she thought on leaving her hometown.



Once in Lviv, she found a shelter offering not only housing but accompaniment in JRS Ukraine. "Fate brought us to JRS. If this meeting with JRS had not happened, I don't know if we could have managed on our own under such circumstances", she says.
