Change Environment! Climate Change & Migration



ne European Unior

This transnational education project connected 204 schools across 7 countries (Spain, Italy, Hungary, Belgium, Ireland, Uganda, Lebanon), reaching 7,671 students and 312 teachers. It addressed the links between climate change and migration through a 4-stage curriculum (available in 7 languages) supported by video and teacher guides.

178 student Climate Change Ambassadors led campaign and advocacy efforts

19 schools engaged in international exchanges with Uganda and Malta.

28 ambassadors from 5 EU countries presented their work at the final conference in Brussels



This is a school-based initiative, active in 8 European countries (Belgium, Spain, Greece, Croatia, Hungary, Italy, Serbia, Portugal). It fosters student civic engagement and migrant integration through collaborative action in schools and communities. Migrant-led organizations play a central role in shaping and implementing the project.









Together for Change



Co-funded by the European Union

6-stage curriculum developed for ages 12-15 and 16-19, covering critical thinking, empathy and civic action

Curriculum available in **10** different language

107 migrants from 37 nationalities completed leadership training in storytelling, public speaking, and community engagement, preparing them to co-lead school activities.




To Serve

One Proposal - Ukraine Crisis Response

This project is the Society of Jesus' coordinated humanitarian response to the Ukraine crisis, led by **JRS Europe and the Xavier Network**, together with local and international Jesuit partners. Launched in 2022, the initiative was created to address the **immediate needs** of those displaced by the war, while simultaneously working on their **long-term integration** into host societies. It remains one of the largest multi-country responses ever coordinated by JRS Europe.

Present in Ukraine, Poland, Slovakia, Hungary, Romania, Moldova, and other parts of Europe, the project is rooted in the Jesuit mission to **serve the** most vulnerable—particularly women, children, and the elderly, who represent the majority of the over 127,700 individuals assisted as of the end of 2024.



Dear European Parliament

Ahead of the 2024 European Parliament elections, we launched the "Dear European Parliament" campaign to inspire young people—especially first-time voters—to engage in democratic life and reflect on the impact EU policies have on migrants and refugees.

Running across four countries (Belgium, Spain, Romania, and **Poland)**, the digital campaign combined short videos, youth dialogues, and social media outreach, focusing on themes such as detention, reception, and protection.

Reached over **3.6 million people**



Over **2,000** redirected to voter engagement platforms like together.eu.



Detention under the spotlight

In 2024, we concluded our first multiyear effort to challenge immigration detention practices across Europe. With 14 country offices involved, and weekly visits by over 100 staff and volunteers, the project offered legal, psychosocial, and pastoral support to around 2,000 detained individuals.

It also generated impactful research, including the report "Detained and Unprotected", highlighting systemic failures in access to justice and legal aid. The Detention Visitors Training held in Malta focused on identifying vulnerabilities in detention, equipping participants with key tools for humane engagement.

By combining data collection, field presence, and local advocacy, the project reaffirmed our commitment to eliminating detention and promoting rights-based alternatives.






