Change

Project coordinator as responsible person since mid 2023 – success factors:

- Collaboration with umbrella organizations of schools (especially Jesuit schools) +Collaboration with reference teachers
- Establishment of a network of young migrants who act as witnesses in schools. Focus on training and agency of these migrants
- Close cooperation with a main donor, whom we regularly invite to take part in interventions in schools - Additional support through Change project calls from JRS Europe is key
- Integrated programming: punctual integration of staff members in Change creates bridge to other projects
- Key difference from our previous work with Change: we worked with volunteers and a team member who added Change to her work - not a good idea, you need to find funds for a reference person in your team!





Plan Together – ATD project of JRS Belgium

Case management project, home accompaniment of undocumented migrants with children (since 2020) – success factors:

- Establishment of trustful relation with Immigration Office (IO) – now: regular case consultation with IO
- Home accompaniment: facilitates establishment of trusting relationship with migrants and strengthens agency
- Regular round table on ATD: building trust, exchanging best practices on ATD
- Key difference with an earlier project: a single person (now a team of three) with responsibility for building and maintaining local networks, rapport and support for receiving families, no case management methodology - burn out as a consequence
