

# Health Track : supporting refugee healthcare professionals

- **advocacy rooted in day-to-day experience** of accompanying refugee doctors (225 people over 3 years)
- **key role played by refugees** themselves in the deployment of advocacy (documentation of situations, speaking out)
- importance of **linking strong scientific analysis to field findings**, and of drawing on an **extra-national dimension** (at European level) to convince national authorities



# L'Oasis : a safe place to rest and care before & after the interview

- **Relevant answer:** based on the needs of asylum seekers (observation phase, preliminary field surveys conducted to design the project, interim assessment...)
- **Fruitful partnership:** collaboration with a partner (Red Cross) offering complementary skills and means to those of JRS + anticipation of the project's long-term sustainability beyond the experimental phase
- **Adequate means:** good mix of staff (3) and volunteers (60), including asylum seekers (20) to match a true warm and human welcome while making the project sustainable
